


Smith Rapids

Features

- 11 campsites
- Drinking water
- Reservable campsites
- Canoe launch on south fork of Flambeau River
- River Saddle Equestrian Trail access with additional overflow parking
- Scenic view of covered bridge



Accessible features include:

Vault toilet facilities, interpretive trail at nearby Round Lake Logging Dam and fishing pier at nearby Newman Lake



Location

Smith Rapids Campground is located on Forest Road 148.


- From Highway 70, turn north on FR 148 and continue for 1.8 miles to campground entrance.

Campsite Capacity

Individual Campsite capacity may not exceed 4 vehicles and 8 people.

- Vehicle capacity limit includes both wheeled camping unit and vehicles

Operation of all ATVs & UTVs are prohibited in campground



Description

This small campground has 11 sites and is located on the South fork of the Flambeau River and provides an ideal focal point for hiking, river fishing, horseback riding (campsite equipped with tie stalls and trailer parking designed for horse camping) and canoeing. Seven campsites are designed to accommodate horse trailers with extra long parking spurs, hitching rails, picnic tables, and fire grills. A carry-in boat access, vault toilets, picnic shelter, and day use picnic area are also provided. All campsites may be reserved through a campground reservation system. A special feature near this campground is the Smith Rapids Covered Bridge.

Maximum RV/Trailer Length of Campsites

(Back-in sites unless indicated below)

Tent Only : 1, 2, 3, 4

25 Foot : 10, 11

40 Foot : 5

45+ Foot : 6, 7, 8, 9

Campground Fees

Individual Campsite fee is \$12, or \$6 with use of Interagency Senior or Access Pass. Interagency Pass discounts apply only to the fee for the campsite physically occupied by the pass holder, not to any additional fee or campsite(s) occupied by members of the pass holder's party.

Firewood Closure Order

Our firewood closure order prohibits the possession, storage, or transport of any firewood that originates from more than 25 miles from your campsite. Firewood certified by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Transportation and Consumer Protection can originate from more than 25 miles from National Forest destination. Both certified firewood and Kiln-dried, untreated/unpainted/unstained/construction/dimensional lumber that is free of any metal or foreign substance is approved. Pallet boards are not approved.
