


Sailor Lake

Vault toilet facilities, some picnic tables and grills at nearby Sailor Lake Picnic day use area



Location

Sailor Lake Campground is located on Forest Road 139.

- From Highway 70, turn south on FR 139 and continue for 2.8 miles to campground entrance road.


Campsite Capacity

Individual Campsite capacity may not exceed 4 vehicles and 8 people.

Double Campsite capacity may not exceed 6 vehicles and 16 people.

- Vehicle capacity limit includes both wheeled camping unit and vehicles

ATVs & UTVs over 50" in width are prohibited in campground and on Flambeau Trail

Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest — Sailor Lake

Description

This is a popular ATV campground offering 25 sites that can accommodate RV's up to 45 feet. There is one double site and three walk in sites. A total of 14 sites can be reserved. A developed boat ramp, scenic picnic shelter, and trail spur providing access to the Flambeau Trail system are also available. Shady campsites include a parking spur, fire grill, picnic table, and tent pad. Drinking water and vault toilets are provided.

Maximum RV/Trailer Length of Campsites

(Back-in sites unless indicated below)

Tent Only: 23, 24, 25

35 Foot : 1, 2, 5, 7, 11, 20

40 Foot : 3, 4, 6, 10, 22

45+ Foot : 9, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18


45+ Foot Pull Thru : 8, 12, 19, 21

Campground Fees

Individual Campsite fee is \$12, or \$6 with use of Interagency Senior or Access Pass.

Double Campsite fee is \$24 and no Interagency Pass discount apply.

Interagency Pass discounts apply only to the fee for the campsite physically occupied by the pass holder, not to any additional fee or campsite(s) occupied by members of the pass holder's party.



Firewood Closure Order

Our firewood closure order prohibits the possession, storage, or transport of any firewood that originates from more than 25 miles from your campsite. Firewood certified by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Transportation and Consumer Protection can originate from more than 25 miles from National Forest destination. Both certified firewood and Kiln-dried, untreated/unpainted/unstained/construction/dimensional lumber that is free of any metal or foreign substance is approved. Pallet boards are not approved.
