


# Eastwood

## Features

- 22 campsites
- Drinking water
- Campground host (summer)
- Some reservable campsites
- Located on the 416 acre Mondeaux Flowage
- Ice Age National Scenic Trail passes near the campground
- Mondeaux Dam Lodge with food, boat rentals, firewood and showers nearby
- Good fishing for musky, northern pike, large mouth bass, crappie, perch, and panfish



Accessible features include:

Vault toilet facilities and fishing pier at nearby Lakeview day use site.



## Location

Eastwood Campground is located on Forest Road 104, along the east side of the Mondeaux Flowage.


- From County Highway D, take FR 104 south for 1.4 miles to campground entrance.

## Campsite Capacity

Campsite capacity may not exceed 4 vehicles and 8 people.

- Vehicle capacity limit includes both wheeled camping unit and vehicles

**Operation of all ATVs & UTVs are prohibited in campground**



# Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest — Eastwood

## Description

Eastwood Campground is located in a mature hardwood forest along the eastern shore of the Mondeaux Flowage. Located near the campground are a variety of commercial services including canoe & boat rentals, showers, and some food and firewood sales at the Mondeaux Dam Lodge. There is no long term or day use parking for people entering the Ice Age National Scenic Trail within the campground. Trash collection is not provided within campground, please pack out own garbage. Dumpster and RV Dump Station are provided by Mondeaux Dam Lodge (Dumping Fees Apply).



## Firewood Closure Order

Our firewood closure order prohibits the possession, storage, or transport of any firewood that originates from more than 25 miles from your campsite. Firewood certified by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Transportation and Consumer Protection can originate from more than 25 miles from National Forest destination. Both certified firewood and Kiln-dried, untreated/unpainted/unstained/construction/dimensional lumber that is free of any metal or foreign substance is approved. Pallet boards are not approved.

## Maximum RV/Trailer Length of Campsites

(Back-in sites only)

25 Foot : 1, 2, 3, 5, 13, 14, 15, 16, 19

30 Foot : 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 18, 21

35 Foot : 17, 20, 22

## Campground Fees

Individual Campsite fee is \$12, or \$6 with use of Interagency Senior or Access Pass. Interagency Pass discount applies only to the fee for the campsite physically occupied by the pass holder, not to any additional fee or campsite(s) occupied by members of the pass holder's party.
